Local art students stage two-woman show

Julie Carol Phillips and Amy Brower, University of Dallas graduate students, will present a two-person show, "Natural Response," at Art Corners Gallery within the Standard Brands Paints at University Drive, Fort Worth.

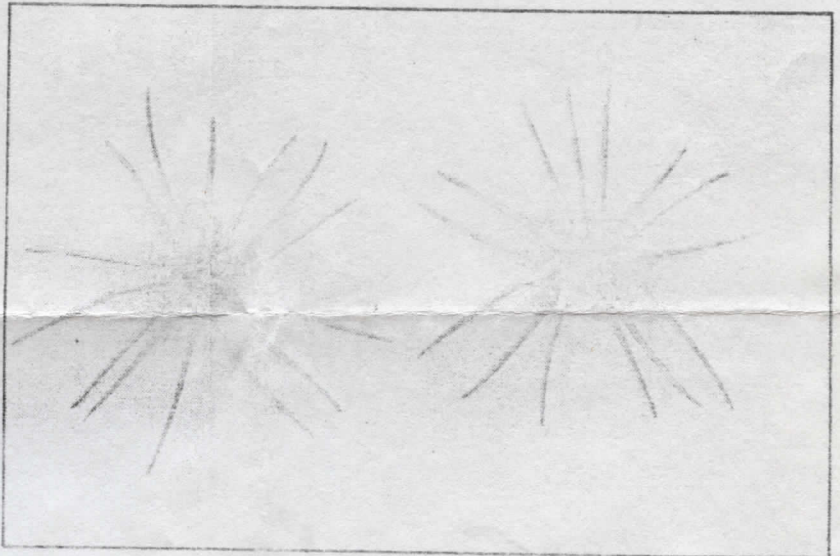
The exhibition runs through July 24. Gallery hours are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. and Saturday and Sunday, 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Amy Brower, a Master of Arts student, will present ceramic sculptures representing nature.

Julie Carol Phillips received her Master of Arts from the University in 1986 and is working toward her Master of Fine Arts in September. Phillips's images are "visual presentations of her spirit — dreams and meditations with an underlying mysterious quality."

The printed or gouache images are organic in form and shape and are often interplayed with an actual third dimension — sewing, cutting, dyeing and paper, thread and ceramic.
