

5 Honorees To Attend Founder Day

Five of six men to receive honorary degrees conferred by the University of Dallas are expected to attend the institution's first annual founder's day on Sept. 28.

Dr. Robert Morris, university president, said only Gen. Douglas MacArthur, recuperating from a recent operation, is not expected to be present for the 5 p.m. ceremony on the scenic campus near Irving.

Three Dallas residents to be honored are the Most Rev. Thomas K. Gorman, bishop of the Dallas-Fort Worth Diocese, and Edward R. Maher and E. Constantin Jr.

All were instrumental in founding the university, now in its fifth year, and they now serve on the executive committee on the board of trustees.
