Catholics Soon to Break Ground for University

Ground will be broken shortly after the first of the year on Highway 183 for the University of Dallas, a Catholic college, and students of all faiths will be enrolled in September.

Dr. F. Kenneth Brasted, university president, made the announcement in a speech before the Fort Worth Serra Club at

noon Wednesday at Hotel Texas.

The school will be operated, he said, by the Sisters of St. Mary of Namur, who now operate Our Lady of Victory College here. Dr. Brasted said the new Catholic university will take over academic functions of OLV.

Dr. Brasted emphasized that American history and economics will be required subjects "as we have seen inroads against loyalty to our nation, inroads against good citizenship and a growing lack of appreciation of our unique American heritage."
