• "Stuart Davis: Prints & Drawings," 26 lithographs & screenprints & 20 drawings by 20th-century American abstract painter. Thru March 9.

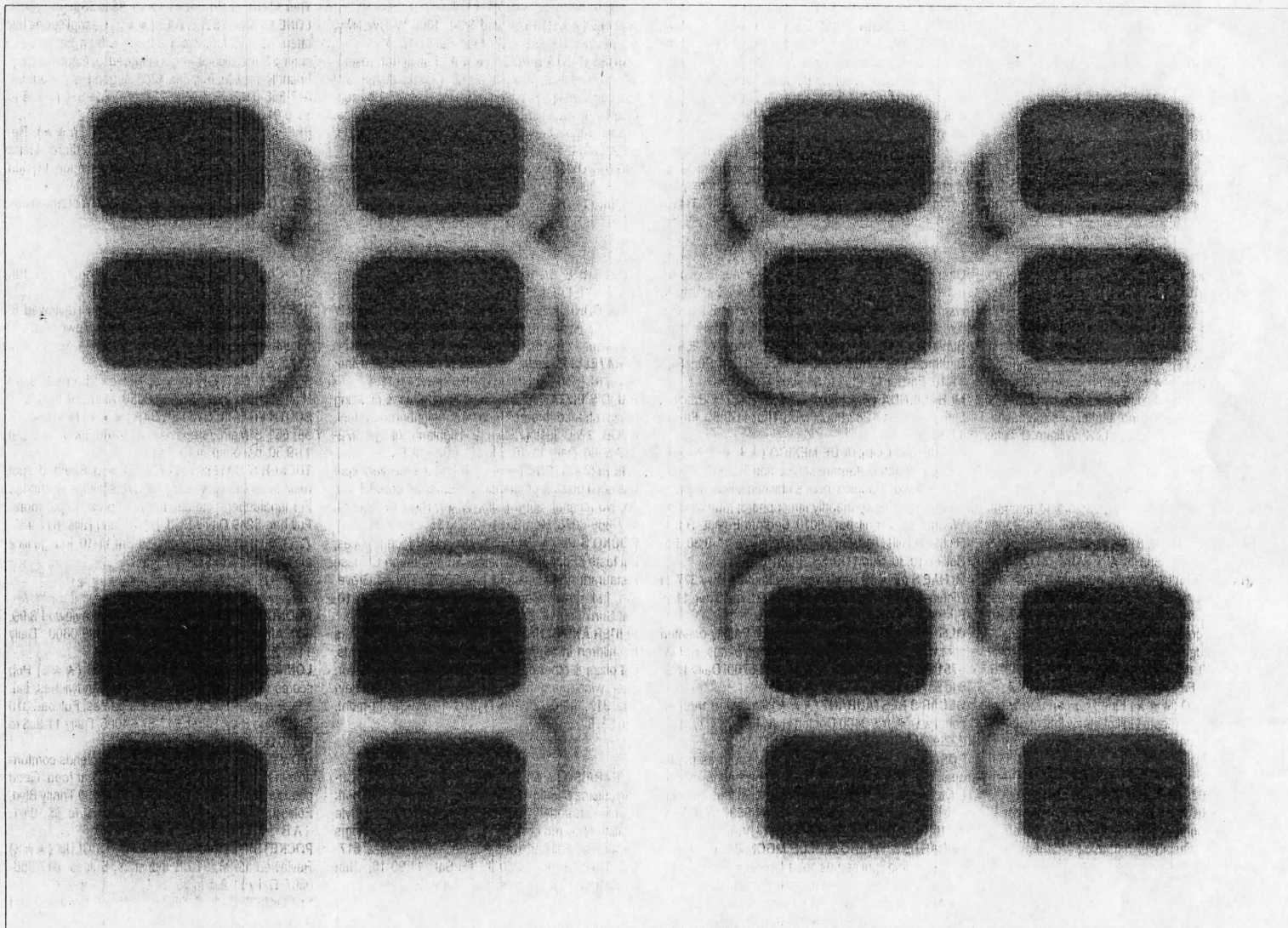
